



## **ASSESSING**

In order to grow, we need to know where we are today and how we can improve. In 2023, 66 organizations and 412 individuals completed the annual Baseline Health Assessment (BHA) and we facilitated 20 BHA Reviews which helped Boards & Senior Leadership teams align and identify action steps to grow. In addition, we launched our SWOT analysis to help teams identify strengths, weaknesses, opportunities, and threats.

### **TRAINING**

We're grateful 95% of nonprofits we surveyed said our training increased awareness and alignment as an organization. We also launched 6 new courses on PathWay, our digital learning platform, including Transformational Fundraising, Staff Leadership & Financial Fundamentals. We're thrilled that 75 organizations have already subscribed to PathWay, enabling them to access our workshop content 24/7 on-demand!



# **IMPLEMENTING**

We spent 263 hours coaching our nonprofits 1:1. We went deep with 31 organizations through our fee-based consulting services. Nonprofits especially benefitted from consulting in Board Governance, Strategic Planning & Transformation Fundraising! We received 100% positive feedback from our consulting clients about their experience. We also celebrate a 4.9/5 rating from our Executive Director Cohort participants.

Academy31 is an all-female private Christian middle school that launched in August 2023. Their mission is to produce godly young women of character & competence, serving families across the Triangle to provide high-quality, truth-based education within a dedicated discipleship community. Academy31 has been highly engaged with every aspect of Mission Triangle's offerings. From taking the BHA, to attending our no-cost workshops and small groups, to leveraging our 1:1 coaching, to feebased consulting, Academy31 has experienced the full Mission Triangle program.



Kimberly Wilson, Academy31's Founder & Head of School, also participates in Mission Triangle's Executive Director Cohort - a group of 7 Directors who meet monthly for peer learning, accountability, community, and encouragement. Academy31 even used Mission Triangle's Root & Fruit leadership health tool to teach their students about personal and spiritual health.

Academy31 is looking forward to launching a new grade level for the 2024-2025 academic year to impact more young women and their families.


